Applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree or above in Ecology and Biodiversity, Biological or Environmental Sciences. Preference will be given to those with experience in database management and public outreach. Applicants with post-qualification experience in marine ecology and familiarity with local intertidal environments would be desirable. They should have a good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese); proficiency in MS Office applications (including Word, Excel and PowerPoint); good communication, interpersonal, leadership and organisational skills; and the ability to work independently and as a team.

The appointee will work for a joint Faculty project on Environmental Sustainability Education. He/She will assist the Project Investigators to oversee the development and operation of programmes used in Hong Kong secondary schools for environmental/ecological teaching and learning resources. He/She will also help develop biological surveys of intertidal habitats, liaise and perform school visits and assist with surveys on the shore, oversee the development of an online database for schools to upload data, and perform other duties as assigned.
